



ACCREDITED INDEPENDENT STALKING ADVOCACY CASEWORKER (ISAC) TRAINING

Paladin knows that training professionals on risk assessment and understanding the stalking law is vital to supporting victims. Advocacy is also vital and trained specialist staff are critical to saving lives and money. In some cases, stalking can lead to physical and sexual violence and even murder.

Paladin have developed an accredited Independent Stalking Advocacy Caseworkers (ISACs) training course through the University of Brighton. This training will enable Paladin to establish a network of ISACs across the UK as satellites to the national service which will save lives, give victims quality of life and reduce levels of isolation. It is vital that there is a network of specialists locally to ensure victims are given the right advice and supported through the Criminal Justice System, much the same as Independent Domestic Violence Advisors (IDVAs) and Independent Sexual Violence Advisers (ISVAs).

It is important that there are more ISACs across the UK as their specialist knowledge and advocacy is vital in keeping victims and their children safe.

This course is designed for those who:

- **Have one year experience working on the frontline with clients experiencing abuse.**
- **Come into contact with victims of stalking both domestic violence related and non-domestic violence related.**
- **Manage those working with clients experiencing abuse and hold a caseload.**
